

Beyond Timberline Packing List:

Camp Timberline provides most of the necessary wilderness equipment for Beyond Timberline. However, you will need to provide the personal items below. Please keep in mind that the weather in Colorado can change rapidly. Rain or snow showers are likely and temperatures can vary from 25 to 80 degrees in a day. This means that wool and synthetic blends are preferred over cotton clothing. Try to bring "layering" clothes that include both cotton and wool/synthetic. (Synthetic means polypropylene, polartec (fleece), synchilla, capilene, etc.) Storage space is limited. Please pack with this in mind.

Water bottles (2)
Sleeping bag- warm (0-25 degree bag)
Stuff sack for sleeping bag
*NO bulky cotton bag!!
Sleeping pad
Socks (5-7 pairs cotton and/or wool)
Underwear
Long pants (2-3)
Shorts (2-3)
T-shirts (3-5)
Sweater/Shirt (1-2)
Flannel/Sweatshirt (1-2)
Long underwear (preferably synthetic/wool/silk)
Rainwear (very important!! waterproof!!)
Jacket- warm
Gloves & or liners
Warm hat
Pillow (optional)
Hiking boots (well broken in!!)
Athletic shoes/sandals
Swimsuit (1 piece for gals)
Toiletries
Towel/washcloth
Flashlight (extra batteries)
Sunscreen & Chap Stick
Bible, notepad, pen, pencil
Insect repellent
Camera/film (optional)

Equipment we provide:

Backpacks
Cooking/Eating utensils
Cook stoves
First aid kits
Tents
Compasses/Maps

Please remember that due to our accommodations; you need to limit your packing to one trunk/hockey bag or a couple of modest duffels. Also, remember everyone will be carrying their own packs while hiking. Make sure you have a sleeping bag that packs well along with other crucial items. We can't stress enough the importance of having the proper hiking boots!! Please make sure your boots are well broken in before you come to camp. There is nothing worse than having aching, blistered feet while on the trail. Tennis shoes will not be worn while hiking. Please let us know if you have any further questions.

Do not bring:

Blow-dryers, curling irons, tapes or CD or mp3 players, electronic games, food, candy, gum, valuables, jewelry, etc...
